An innovative and exciting service Belstead road demonstrates the approach to development that Consensus support services will become renowned for.

Currently in development, Belstead Road will provide two services close to Ipswich town centre with access to local facilities and resources.

A new, purpose built, six person service will provide support to young adults with a learning disability and complex needs. The environment has been designed to support the needs of people with Autistic Spectrum Disorder who are in transition from children to adult services.

A 4 person service is also being developed. Designed to provide individual flats, the service will support people who for a variety of reasons, may require a 'single' service. Additional communal areas will provide

opportunities for socialisation and life skills training.

Belstead road seeks to provide environments tailored to meet the needs of those people for whom residential support is of most benefit today whilst support provided will focus on enabling people to develop skills and abilities for living in non-registered supported or independent living accommodation. With this in mind both services will offer accommodation that is fully wheelchair accessible.

Using person centred approaches, working with people to agree appropriate outcomes and identify how to support people to achieve them. Belstead road will seek to provide people with opportunities and experiences that lead to greater control, independence and inclusion.
